About the Club

The Polaris Sailing Society is an organization for single adults striving to provide its members with sailing experiences on a variety of boats. The club also organizes social gatherings, and conducts programs and educational activities related to sailing.

Meetings are held every Thursday evening at 7:30pm at Silver Gate Yacht Club on Harbor Island. On the second Thursday of each month there is usually a scheduled formal business meeting which is kept as brief as possible. The general meetings are typically comprised of a short business session and a program featuring either a guest speaker or a presentation. At these meetings, members can assist you with making arrangements for you to go sailing on the weekend and/or weekday depending on the availability of boats and no sailing experience is required.

Upcoming social and sailing events are announced. Guests are welcome to join in the events, and are encouraged to attend up to three events (a meeting, social event, or sailing, etc.) before deciding to become a member. By being a member, you have potential access to all club boats. As a matter of information the club does not own any boats. All of the boats used for sailing events, are owned and maintained by club members.

After you have been a guest for NO MORE than three functions, you are asked to decide if you want to become a member in order to continue enjoying the benefits of Polaris.

Membership

Becoming a member of the Polaris Sailing Society is very simple, and there are only two qualifications:

- You are single.
- You pay \$75 per year dues.

That's all there is to it!

Dues are paid annually, with a renewal date that will be one year + the first day of the month following the original joining date.

To join, simply walk up to the membership table at a Polaris meeting and just say "I would like to join", may I please have an "Application Form and an Assumption of Risk and Liability Release Agreement".
